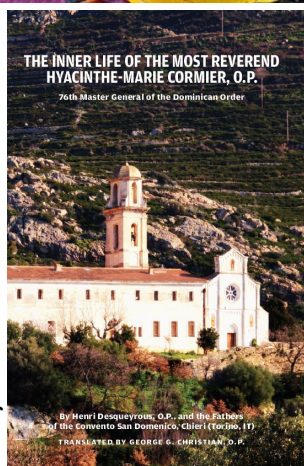


The Inner Life of the Most Reverend Hyacinthe-Marie Cormier, OP: 76th Master General of the Dominican Order

The state in which I lived up to now is a kind of Luke warmness; I divided myself between the world and God. Perhaps many others, on being no more negligent than I, were abandoned. What gratitude I owe to God for His having followed me in my indifference (p. 17)

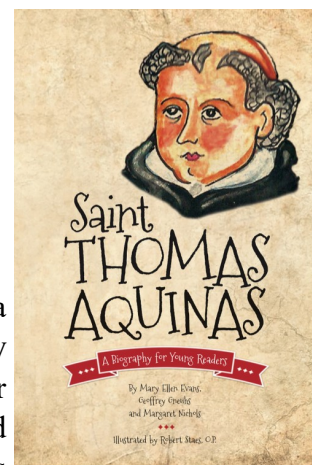

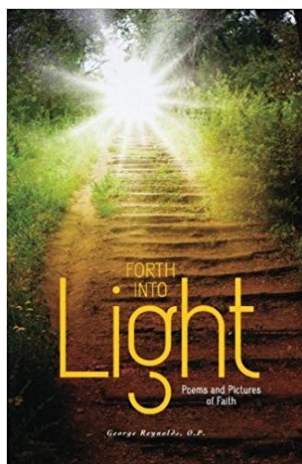

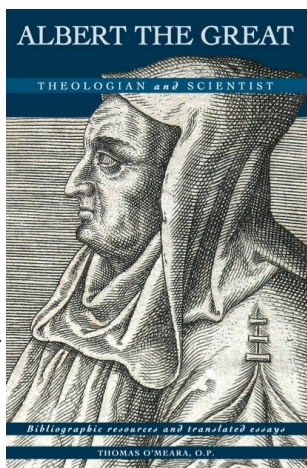

by Pierre-Andre Liégé

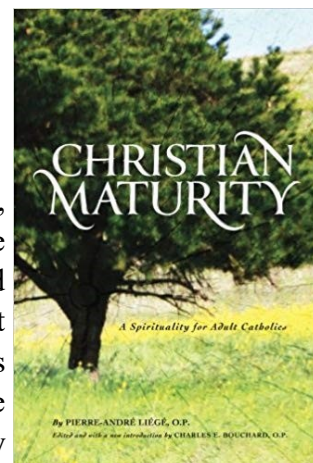
Written in the late 1950s, this translation of the French has been revised with a new introduction. It was one of the first serious attempts to integrate psychology and the study of human development into
