




New Priory Press is a successor of the “old” Priory Press, founded in 1952. During its heyday the Priory Press published scholarly works by many Dominican authors, including Walter Farrell, Benedict Ashley and Kevin O’Rourke. It produced a series of college and high school textbooks that are in use to this day.

New Priory Press was founded in 2013 by the Dominican Friars of the Province of St. Albert the Great in Chicago. Its purpose is to promote the scholarship and publication of works that foster the province’s Dominican intellectual heritage and to provide serious scholarship in accessible form to adult Catholics.

The **New Priory Press** will continue this tradition by focusing on Dominican theology, spirituality and history. It will publish new works, such as Thomas O’Meara’s collection of translated essays on St. Albert the Great, Benedict Ashley’s autobiography, and reprints or translations of historically important works. We will also publish resources for use by members of the Dominican Family, including the Liturgical Calendar for the Order of Preachers in English. These will be available as on-demand, hard copies or as Kindle e-books.






Recently we have re-organized our catalogue into three distinct collections:

As a small publishing house, with approximately fifty titles at present, we have been performing modestly well. Since sales officially started, we have sold close to 6,000 units, and growing. Our sales have been chiefly in the United States, with Europe followed by the United Kingdom. Our main distribution has been through Amazon.com followed by our own online store, then other retailers and gift shops. We are in the process of revising the **New Priory Press** website to make it more user-friendly. And soon we will be moving from our website market to a more economic sales format.
