



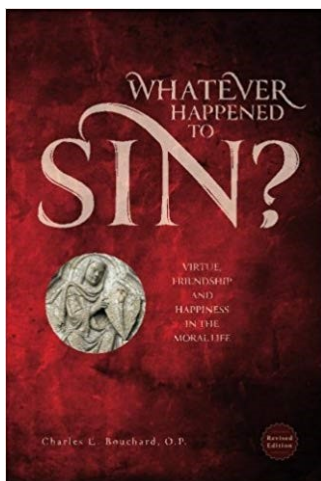
Whatever Happened to SIN?: Virtue, Friendship and Happiness in the Moral Life.

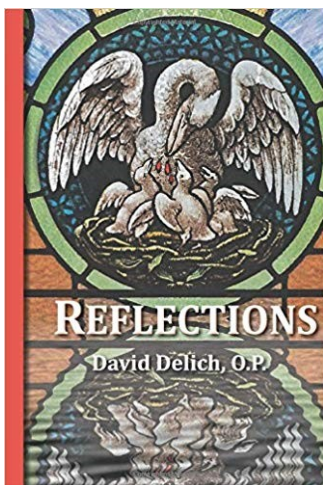
The Spirituality of the Celtic Saints

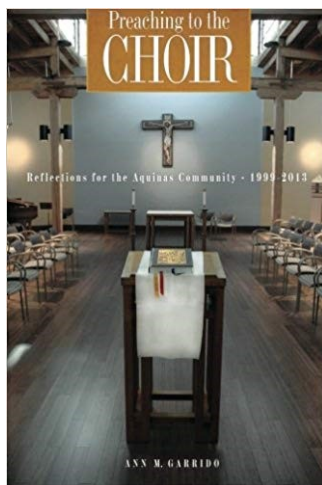

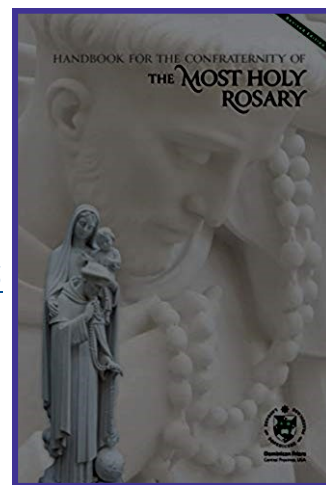
Handbook for the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary
