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INTRODUCTION

This Liturgical Calendar follows the **Roman Calendar** (1969), adapted for use in the Provinces of the United States by including the **Proper Calendar for the Dioceses of the United States of America** (as found in the **Roman Missal** 2011) and the **Calendar of the Order of Preachers** (approved by the General Curia of the Friars on 15 May 2018 and approved by the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments on 14 April 2019). Celebrations proper to the Province of St. Joseph the Worker are indicated. For the most part only what pertains to the celebration of the Eucharist is noted.

References to the **Liturgy of the Hours** are limited to indicating the proper week of the four-week psalter to be used and an occasional reference to customs proper to the Order.

I. THE CALENDAR:

- A. **Holy Days of Obligation** [USA]: By a decision of the USCCB confirmed by the Congregation for Bishops on July 4, 1992, whenever January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, or August 15, the Solemnity of The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, or November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints, falls on a Saturday or on a Monday, the precept to attend Mass is abrogated.
- B. **Vigil Masses:** Certain celebrations [e.g., The Nativity of the Lord (Christmas), Pentecost Sunday, and The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary] have proper Vigil Masses in addition to the Mass for the day itself. These Vigil Masses are intended to be used either before or after First Vespers (Evening Prayer I) of the feastday.
- C. **Saturdays in Ordinary Time:** When there is no Obligatory Memorial, an Optional Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary is allowed (**RC**, 15). Whenever this Optional Memorial is allowed, the special votive Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary proper to the Order may be used as an alternative, i.e.:
 - OP Votive Mass of the BVM
 - Wh MASS pref I or II of BVM
 - RDGS rdgs of the weekday *or* proper:
 - (A) Eph 1:3-6,16-19 [710.4]/ Resp. Ps [572]/ Lk 1:39-47 [712.5] *or*
 - (B) Eph 3:14-19 [740.7]/ Ps 16 [721.1]/ Jn 19:25-27 [712.12]
- D. **The Celebration of Patronal Feasts:** In addition to the celebrations proper to each province, a community should celebrate the following:
 - a. Solemnity of the anniversary of the Dedication of their particular church on the anniversary day of the dedication, if the church was consecrated. If the day of dedication is unknown, this solemnity is observed on Oct 22;
 - b. Solemnity of the titular saint of their church;
 - c. Solemnity of the principal patron of their house;
 - d. Feast of the anniversary of the Dedication of the Cathedral;

- e. Feast of the principal patron of the diocese, territory, province, or more extensive territory; and
 - f. Obligatory Memorial of a Saint or Blessed (mentioned in the **Martyrology** or its Appendix) whose body is preserved in their church or oratory.
- NB: The celebration of the patron of a province of a religious order is observed as a Feast (**RC** - Table of Liturgical Days, 8d).

E. **The Celebration of Dominican Feasts:** When the feast of a Dominican Saint of Blessed found in this Calendar is celebrated with the higher rank of a Solemnity, the readings given in this Calendar should be arranged as follows:

- 1st Reading = Old Testament
(except during the Easter Season when the first reading is always taken from the New Testament)
- Responsorial Psalm
- 2nd Reading = New Testament
- Gospel Acclamation
- Gospel
- When it is a question of celebrating a patronal feast (as listed above), the same principle applies when arranging the readings. When proper readings are not provided, they are taken from the appropriate Common.
- On Solemnities the *Gloria* and Creed are said (on Feasts only the *Gloria*) as well as the proper preface, if there is one, or a preface from the appropriate Common.
- On Memorials the common prefaces for the various categories of Saints may also be used.

II. THE READINGS:

- A. The cycles of readings for 2020 are: Sundays: Year A
Weekdays: Year II
- B. In this Liturgical Calendar the references to the daily Mass readings follow the chapter and verse enumeration of the **New American Bible** as revised for the **Lectionary for Mass, 4 vols. (1998-2002)**. The number for the readings given in brackets refers to this same **Lectionary**.

For Sundays, Solemnities and Feasts, the exact text references are given. For Obligatory Memorials and Optional Memorials only the references to the semi-continuous readings are given except for the few memorials that have assigned readings (e.g., Jun 11 - St. Barnabas). On days when a Memorial of a Saint is celebrated, for compelling reasons texts may be taken from the Proper of Saints or selected from the Commons of the Saints. However, the celebrant will make sure not to omit too often or without sufficient cause the readings assigned for each day in the weekday **Lectionary**. (See: **IL**, n.83).

- C. **Choice of Readings for Dominican Celebrations:** The use of proper readings for Dominican celebrations depends upon the rank of the celebration and is governed by the following norms:
- SOLEMNITY:
Three readings are used and are taken from the proper.
 - FEAST:
Two readings are used and are taken from the proper or, if there are no proper readings, from the appropriate Common.
 - OBLIGATORY OR OPTIONAL MEMORIAL:
Two readings are used. These may be taken from the proper readings, if there are some, or from the weekday.

III. TYPOGRAPHY OF THIS CALENDAR:

- Italics:* 1. indicate an element of the liturgy of the day which is optional, e.g., *seq*;
2. indicate an Optional Memorial, e.g., Dec 4, *St. John Damascene*.

A text set off by a short single line indicates explanatory material, e.g.:

* = explanatory texts from the Roman rites and documents, e.g., Feb 26;
or
OP = explanatory or liturgical texts proper to the Order, e.g., Dec 22.

The rank of a feastday is indicated by both letters (S, F, M) and typography, e.g.:

- **CHRISTMAS (S)** - **St. Andrew (F)** - St. Francis Xavier (M)
- Optional Memorials are indicated by *italic type* placed within brackets.

NB: The *Gloria* [gl] and Creed [cr] are said only when indicated in the Liturgical Calendar. The *Gloria* is not said on Memorials or weekdays. Days on which Eucharist Prayer I would have proper *communicantes* are indicated as follows: *prop Roman Canon inserts*.

NB: - Feastdays of whatever rank that are proper to the United States are indicated by the addition: USA
- Feastdays of whatever rank that are proper only to Nigeria are indicated by the addition: Nigeria

IV. LITURGY OF THE HOURS

In this Calendar, only a reference to the appropriate week of the Hour-Week Psalter is provided and this is placed on each Sunday, regardless of the rank of the day. Solemnities, Feasts and certain other days may have proper psalms which replace those of the weekday, however, this is not noted in this Calendar.

At the conclusion of this celebration, as is the custom in the liturgical tradition of our Order, the Genealogy according to Matthew (1:1-16) may be sung.

If necessary, the chant, that is, the solemn proclamation of the Genealogy, may be sung in the manner proper to the Gospel by a cantor who is not a deacon (as the norms for the singing of the Easter Proclamation allow). It may be sung either in Latin using the Gregorian chant in the **Missale et Lectionarium OP** (1985), pp.510-514, or in the vernacular using a suitable melody composed or adapted for it. It may also be proclaimed in a recitative style with a musical harmony as a background and with the addition *ad libitum* of some acclamations for the people interspersed throughout the proclamation.

SEASON OF LENT

OP 1. The season of Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday exclusive. This season retains its penitential character and serves as a preparation for the celebration of Easter.

2. Penitential practices during Lent: According to Church law each Friday in Lent is observed as a day of abstinence; Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are observed as days of fast and abstinence.

Keeping in mind the tradition and legislation of the Order, the following should be observed to the extent that they apply: (a) determinations laid down by various Provincial Chapters concerning the forms of fasting and abstinence; (b) the statutes of particular Conventual Chapters; and (c) the Directories for Nuns regarding proper acts of self-denial for their communities.

3. If it seems appropriate, on Ash Wednesday or on other days during Lent in place of the former rite of the penitential psalms some communal penitential celebration or "rite of reconciliation" may be held, whether it be sacramental or non-sacramental (according to the spirit of the **Rite of Penance**, nn.36-37). However, this celebration may not immediately precede Mass.

- * During Lent the *Alleluia* is always omitted at Mass and Office. The *Gloria* is said at Mass only on Solemnities and Feasts.

LITURGY OF THE HOURS

OP Compline (Night Prayer):

1. If Compline (Night Prayer) is sung, the *In pace* response may be used in place of "Into your hands." The antiphons *Evigila* or *O Rex* may be used in place of the gospel canticle antiphon "Keep us safe."
2. If Compline (Night Prayer) is not sung, the antiphons *Evigila* and *O Rex* may be used for the gospel canticle at Evening Prayer in place of the regular antiphon. This may be done at Evening Prayer I and II of Sundays of Lent.
3. The chant *Media vita* may be used in place of the short response whether at Compline (Night Prayer) or at Vespers (Evening Prayer) – or even at other celebrations, such as a penitential liturgy on Ash Wednesday or on Thursday of Holy Week (before the beginning of the Easter Triduum). Note that this chant is not an antiphon (as wrongly indicated in our books) and should no longer be used as such.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Deacons may bring blessed ashes to the sick and those confined to their homes. If a minister is not available, a family member or another person may bring the blessed ashes to a shut-in, using one of the formulas in the **Roman Missal** to impose ashes.
 - * The blessing and distribution of ashes may also take place outside Mass. In this case, the rite is preceded by a Liturgy of the Word, with the Entrance Antiphon, the Collect, and the readings with their chants as at Mass. Then there follow the Homily and the blessing and distribution of ashes. The rite is concluded with the Universal Prayer, the Blessing and the Dismissal of the Faithful.

- OP When for pastoral reasons the blessing and distribution of ashes takes place outside Mass, it may be appropriately joined to some hour of the Office, especially Midday Prayer or the Office of Readings.

- OP** 1. On this day the Church recalls the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem to accomplish his Paschal Mystery. Accordingly, the memorial of this entrance of the Lord takes place at all Masses, by means of the Procession or Solemn Entrance before the conventual Mass or the Simple Entrance before other Masses. The Solemn Entrance, but not the Procession, may be repeated before other Masses that are usually celebrated with a large gathering of people.
2. Palms may be distributed either when all are gathered or immediately after the blessing before the proclamation of the Gospel, i.e., the Gospel of the Procession.

3. After the Procession or Solemn Entrance, the greeting and Penitential Act or the blessing and sprinkling of water and, if appropriate, the *Kyrie* (Lord, have mercy) are omitted and the Collect of the Mass concludes the procession; Mass continues in the usual way.

4. The narrative of the Lord's Passion is read without candles and without incense, with no greeting or signing of the book. It is read by a Deacon or, if there is no Deacon, by a Concelebrant or the Principal Celebrant himself. It may also be read by readers, whether religious (brothers cooperators, nuns and sisters) or lay, with the part of Christ, if possible, reserved to a Deacon or a Priest. Deacons, but not others, ask for the blessing of the Principal Celebrant before singing the Passion, as at other times before the Gospel.

* The Mass for Palm Sunday is provided with three readings. It is strongly recommended that all three be used, unless pastoral reasons suggest otherwise.

Given, however, the importance of the account of the Lord's Passion, the priest, having in mind the character of each individual congregation, is authorized to choose only one of the two readings prescribed before the Gospel, or if necessary, he may read only the account of the Passion, even in the shorter form. This permission applies, however, only to Masses celebrated with a congregation.

The Passion begins directly, without the greeting or the acclamation of the people, but concludes in the usual manner.

OP If appropriate, today or on another day of this week, following the tradition of the Order, in place of the ancient rite of the Penitential Psalms some communal penitential celebration or "rite of reconciliation" may take place, – whether it be sacramental or non-sacramental – according to the spirit of the **Rite of Penance** (nn.36-37) and the norms of liturgical law. However, this celebration may not immediately precede Mass.

OP 1. The Easter Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of Christ is the culmination of the entire liturgical year. (RC, n.18)

2. The Easter Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, reaches its high point in the Easter Vigil, and closes with Vespers (Evening Prayer) on Easter Sunday. (RC, n.19)

3. During these days it is desirable that brothers and sisters who are sick, especially those in hospitals, should be helped to consider the meaning of sickness which is lived in union with the Paschal Mystery of Christ. For this reason the sick should share in or be participants in the liturgical celebrations of the community.

4. Therefore, keeping in mind their varying and different circumstances, everything should be so arranged that in a more suitable manner the sick may have the possibility of receiving Communion and, if possible, participating in the Adoration of the Cross on Good Friday. The various faculties found in the Ritual should be freely used.

Indeed our concern, which is manifested through our care and our prayer, furnishes the strongest witness to the mutual bonds by which we are united by the Gospel concerning our faith in God and the power of the Resurrection of his Son.

* In accordance with a most ancient tradition of the Church, on this day all Masses without the people are forbidden. Where a pastoral reason requires it, the local Ordinary may permit another Mass to be celebrated in churches and oratories in the evening and in case of genuine necessity, even in the morning, but only for the faithful who are in no way able to participate in the evening Mass.

OP 1. The rite of the *Mandatum* may be celebrated by the friars outside Mass in the chapter room, or in the cloister, or in another suitable place.

While the *Mandatum* is carried out, the Gospel may be read (Jn 13:1-17 or some other excerpt from Jn 13-17) and some of the customary chants for the *Mandatum* (see **OHS**, pp.91-98) or other appropriate chants may be sung.

2. The *Sermo Dominicus* (Jn 13:1-14:31) may be used at table in the vernacular or as the last celebration of the day. In this case it is read in place of Compline (Night Prayer) with the community gathered before the Blessed Sacrament.

3. At a suitable time after the celebration of this day is concluded, the altar is stripped and, if possible, crosses are removed from the church. It is desirable to cover any crosses which remain in the church. Holy water is removed from containers in the church.

4. A major prelate presides at the principal hours of the Office and at Mass. The principal hours of the Office begin on the right side of choir.

Today and tomorrow at the conclusion of Lauds (Morning Prayer) in place of the intercessions found in the **Liturgy of the Hours** the *Versus litanici* may be sung, either in Latin with the Gregorian melodies (see **OHS**, pp.60-63) or in the vernacular using suitable melodies composed for them. At the end, after a pause for silence, the Lord's Prayer is said aloud as is the custom at the end of Lauds (Morning Prayer).
3. The special rite for the Adoration of the Cross (as found in the **Missale et Lectionarium OP** (1985), pp.36-43) may be used, observing the adaptations of the restored liturgy regarding the ministers, the color of vestments (red) and the way such special elements fit into the ritual action as a whole. The verses for the Reproaches (*Popule meus, Quid eduxi, Quid ultra*) may be sung with the help of cantors or, if necessary, simply proclaimed.
4. Compline (Night Prayer) is said after the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord at a suitable hour. Two candles are lit.

NOTE:

- a) Today and tomorrow at the Office of Readings and Lauds (Morning Prayer), candles may be lit only at the altar in the usual manner, the number and manner conforming to that of Solemnities. They remain lit during the entire Office.
- b) At a suitable time the altar is stripped; however, the cross remains.
- c) Today after the Adoration of the Cross the brothers, when entering and leaving choir, bow profoundly to the cross as on other days, but they do not genuflect.
- d) Today the *De profundis* for deceased brothers and benefactors and the *Fidelium* are omitted at grace for meals. The custom of wearing the cappa in the refectory, where it exists, may be observed, unless it seems expedient to do otherwise.

3. The Easter Proclamation, if necessary, may be sung even by a cantor who is not a Deacon, e.g., nuns in their own monasteries. In this case, however, the cantor omits the words "Therefore, dearest friends" up to the end of the invitation along with the greeting "The Lord be with you."

- * The paschal candle is lit in all the more solemn liturgical celebrations of this period.
- * Nine readings are assigned to the Easter Vigil: seven from the Old Testament and two from the New. If circumstances demand in individual cases, the number of prescribed readings may be reduced. Three selections from the Old Testament, however, should be read before the epistle and Gospel, although when necessary two may be read. In any case, the reading from Exodus about the escape through the Red Sea (reading 3) should never be omitted.
